Our After School Club is a place where every child feels welcome, valued, and safe. In line with our school's values of Ready, Respectful, and Safe, and our Christian values of Courage, Compassion, and Respect, we ask all children and families to support these expectations so that our club remains a positive and enjoyable environment for everyone.

Our Expectations

Be Ready

- Arrive promptly and prepared to join in with activities.
- Listen carefully to adults and follow instructions the first time.
- Take responsibility for belongings and tidy up after activities.

Be Respectful

- Speak kindly and use good manners towards children and adults.
- Respect the feelings, property, and opinions of others.
- Look after the club's equipment and environment.

Be Safe

- Move sensibly around all areas and use equipment appropriately.
- Stay within agreed areas and listen to adults at all times.
- Tell an adult if something is worrying or upsetting you.

Living Our Christian Values

- Courage: Try new things, persevere, and make good choices even when it's hard.
- Compassion: Be kind and helpful to others; think about how your actions affect them.
- Respect: Treat everyone with fairness and dignity, celebrating our differences.

When Behaviour Falls Short of Expectations

We understand that children may sometimes make mistakes. Staff will always support children to reflect and make better choices. However, behaviour that consistently or seriously falls short of these expectations may result in a review of a child's place at the club.

- Parents/carers will be informed of concerns and given a final warning that continued inappropriate behaviour could result in removal from the provision.
