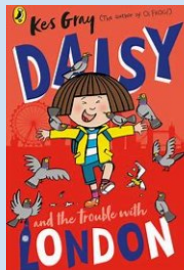
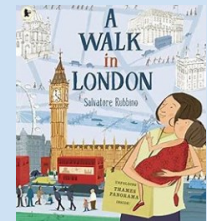
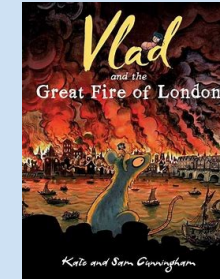

Maths

This half term will be looking at length and height. We will be measuring in centimetres and metres. The children will be comparing lengths and heights in problem solving questions. We will also be looking at measuring mass in terms of grams and kilograms.

Key Vocabulary

Kilograms—A unit of measurement greater than a gram.

Grams—A unit of measurement

Centimetres— a unit of length. 100 cm is the same as 1 metre.

Metres— a unit of length. 1 metre is the same as 100cm.
