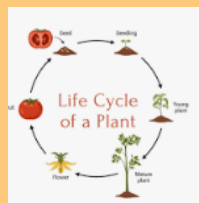




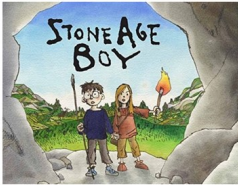

Home Learning Tips

Keep practising your 3, 4, 5 & 8 times tables and counting on in tens from any two digit number.

Focus on reading one school level reading book a week until your child can read that book with 100% accuracy and fluently. Whilst reading with your child, identify different sentence types and word classes.

Remember to ask your child questions about the text they're reading. E.G Why has the character done that? What do you think will happen next and why?

	Word class	Different categories of words used in grammar (noun, verb, adjective, adverb)
	Poetic forms	How a poem is structured, including things like line length and rhyme.
	Shape poems	A poem where the words are arranged to form the shape of the object.

Lengths and Perimeter : To be able to measure length using mm/cm/m and measure the perimeter of simple 2D shapes Fractions: Comparing and ordering fractions, counting in fractions and equivalent fractions.	Length:	Length: The measurement of how long something is from one end to the other, usually measured in mm, cm and m.
	Perimeter:	The total distance around the edge of a shape or object, measured by adding up the lengths of all the sides.
	Numerator	The top number of a fraction showing the number of parts.
	Denominator	The number of equal parts the item is divided into.
