We are delighted to share that our school has been invited to take part in the Highcliffe Food and Arts Festival 13th-14th June!

As part of this exciting event, children are invited to enter an art competition. There are 2 categories:

- Foundation & Key Stage 1
- Key Stage 2

Prizes in each category:

- 1 First Prize: £40
- 2 Second Prize: £30
- 3 Third Prize: £20

How to take part:

Children should create a piece of artwork inspired by the artist Giuseppe Arcimboldo, who is famous for creating portraits made entirely from objects such as fruit, vegetables, flowers, and other foods.

Children can:

- Use real food to create a design and submit a photograph
- Draw, paint, or sketch food into a portrait or landscape
- Create 3D designs using materials such as papier-mâché




There are lots of creative possibilities!

Important information

- Closing date for entries: Tuesday 9th June
- Judging in school: Wednesday 10th June
- Please do not send in real food items, as there will be a delay between judging and the exhibition. If food is used, please send a photograph instead.
- Please make sure you include your child's first name, class and their age on their entry. These will be displayed during the festival so please only include their full name if you are happy for this to be displayed.
- Please hand all entries to your child's class teacher.
