Volunteers will be supervised by the trainers but please be aware that you will support a group of children to practise crossing the road.
Consent	Please consent to the training via the trips section on Arbor. If we do not receive your consent, your child will be unable to take part.
Medical Declaration	Epi Pens and inhalers will be taken when the children leave the school site.
