Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to announce that this year, Year 6 will be participating in a Legacy project aimed at raising money to leave a lasting mark on the Highcliffe community and our school. To achieve this, the children have chosen to take part in one of three fundraising activities:

- Triathlon on Monday 6th July
- Bake Sale on Tuesday 7th and Friday 10th July
- Car Wash on Friday 10th July

Your child will be able to tell you which they are involved in.

Triathlon – Monday 6th July

The children participating in the triathlon will use sponsorship forms to collect donations for the legacy they wish to leave. On the day, they should come to school dressed in their PE kit with suitable footwear and bring a bicycle, swimming kit, and a refillable water bottle. The event will consist of riding 12 laps of our school field, running 6 laps, and swimming 10 lengths of our pool. Attached to this email is a sponsorship form; please ensure that any money collected is given to your child's class teacher or the school office by Monday 6th July.

Bake Sale – Tuesday 7th July and Friday 10th May, 14:50 – 15:30 KS2 Playground

For the bake sale, the children will create nut-free baked goods to sell after school. School will provide the basic ingredients for these goods such as flour, eggs, butter and milk. If your child would like to add additional ingredients, they will bring a list of these home and we would appreciate parent support in providing these. **These additional ingredients will need to be brought to school on the day your child will be baking**, as we will be baking during school time on the 7th, 9th and 10th. Please provide a large container for your child's baked goods, which will be kept in school until the sale. Each cake will be sold for £1 – please ensure that you have the correct change.

Car Wash – Friday 10th July

The children taking part in the car wash will be washing cars belonging to school staff. They should come to school in old, suitable clothing and bring a change of clothes to wear after the activity. Staff opting to have their car washed will be doing so at their own risk!

In addition to these fundraising activities, our Year 6 students will also be involved in several other projects to contribute to our community and school. They will be painting canvases, writing letters to the new intake of Foundation children to welcome them and share insights about their journey through our school, and will leave their mark by creating three Peace
