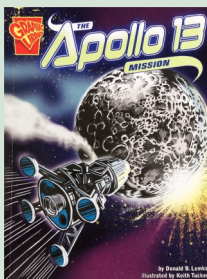


Home Learning Tips

English	Key Vocabulary	Definition
To write a recount based on the Apollo 13 space mission. Children will learn and apply discrete grammar to their writing. In Reading, children will read a range of challenging texts and retrieve information.	Coordinating conjunctions	Connects two main clauses in a sentence to create a compound sentence.
	Sentence	A group of words which includes a subject (noun) and a verb. It makes sense on its own.
	Fragment	A group of words that is not a complete sentence. Fragments often lack a subject, verb or both.

Subject	Outcome
Science	To identify the effects of air, water resistance and friction on moving surfaces. (Forces)
Art	To draw with depth, emotion and movement.
PSHE	To develop strategies in order to maintain relationships.
Music	To identify the structure of a piece of music, to improvise and play a melody with accuracy (Here Come The Egyptians)
Humanities	To describe at least four of the key aspects of the human and physical geography of the Alps to answer the enquiry question, 'What is life like in the Alps?'
French	To recognise and sort nouns by gender and number, and to explain the effect this may have on an adjective.
