Reading and writing simple labels and sentences. Using 'think it, say it, write it, read it' encouraging the children to verbalise their ideas before writing. Practising using finger spaces in sentences. Using our phonics to segment and blend with increasing fluency. Using phonics to write words, labels and sentences. Predicting and answering simple questions about what has happened in our stories. Read back sentences to check it makes sense.	Sentence	A group of words.
	Finger space	A space between each word.
	Capital letter	An upper case letter used to begin sentences and names.
	Full stop	The punctuation mark used at the end of a sentence.
	Phoneme	The sound a letter makes.
	Grapheme	The written form of a sound.
